Dear Julio:

I was not able to get as much support from Texas as I had hoped, but I am having RCUH send you a check for \$1,500 of which \$452.00 is for the difference between the \$1,000 I advanced you for field work and going back to Guatemala, and the balance for your personal services in connection with the project through phases 1, 2 and 3, plus a \$500 advance against Maria collecting data from P.Mex. In other words, \$548.00 is for you personally and for which I will need a receipt for personal services. I will also need an accounting on actual expenses for the field work and your trip to Guatemala (include air ticket stub) and for Maria's trip to the P.Mex office to take off their data.

Progress here is so slow, I don't see how we can have a map put together in time for the Managua date. In checking against the McConnel values we got from Geller for various places, it looks like a constant will apply for the data we have for both Nicaragua and El Salvador. However, things are fouled up in both Costa Rica and Guatemala. I am writing Geller for site descriptions to see if this might clarify things. For example, it looks like McConnel is using the new airport at Guatemala, and the values I have are for the old airport, or vice versa. If you can get the ties, it would be a help.

Incidentally, I can't find a copy of your paper giving values and station descriptions in Central America. Could you send me a copy?
